# **ROLE OVERVIEW**

#### **PRIMARY DUTIES**

Safety and efficiency are the highest priorities for our rig drivers. It begins with thorough pre- and post-trip inspections and carefully following all State and Federal DOT regulations. Daily duties include running a set route, making deliveries and pickups, reporting maintenance issues, and communicating any potential delays. Schedules vary by location and may include four- or five-day workweeks; weekends are typically off. Some loading and unloading is included requiring a forklift certification.
